

What can you expect from the Vertas Playground Inspection and Maintenance Service?

Your responsibility

The Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 imposes a responsibility on those providing children's equipped playgrounds to ensure that they are 'Fit for Purpose'.

The Industry recommends that play equipment should be inspected (Risk Assessed) on a regular basis to ensure faulty equipment is identified and action taken to prevent injury to the user of the facility.

The inspection regime should take the form of:

- Routine visual inspection: daily or at least weekly visual inspection recorded in writing to check for obvious defects
- ✓ Operational inspection: technical assessment made to check for wear and tear, structural stability, integrity of sealed parts and continued suitability of site (fit for purpose)
- Annual inspection: Independent assessment of equipment by a qualified Engineer trained and experienced in the design and installation of fixed play equipment. Vertas is able to commission this work, if required and would typically be via RoSPA.

What is included In our Operational Inspection?

Risks prioritised in accordance with our staged approach, i.e. high, medium and low risks

- Serious defects / faulty equipment reported immediately after it is discovered
- Inspections carried out in accordance with industry standards, i.e. BS EN 1176 (playground equipment) and BS EN 1177 (playground safety surfacing)
- A written report providing a detailed condition assessment of play equipment and general site
- Recommendations for urgent and future action
- A record of inspection to help defend litigation claims should there be an unfortunate accident involving injury to a child using the play equipment
- ✓ **Trained staff** with appropriate public liability insurance

What is **NOT** included but is available at an additional cost


- Repairs to equipment found to be faulty
- Faulty equipment rendered inoperable

- Replacement of any equipment found to be damaged, faulty or defective and beyond repair
- Re-design of playground to improve play values and safety. NB. Please note that Vertas offer a separate design and build service for playground design and installation
